Laurie Griffith, Director of the Cherry Creek Learning Center, believes that Hope Online is an effective way to educate students who struggled to succeed at their previous schools. Committed to Hope Online's unique model for delivering an online education program, Ms. Griffith launched Cherry Creek Learning Center in 2006 to provide her community with an online education option.

Hope Online at Cherry Creek Learning Center serves nearly 100 students of diverse backgrounds. Many students are from low-income, Spanish-speaking families, and they travel east, west, south, and from as far north as Thornton for one-on-one attention and customized curriculum accessed in a safe atmosphere.

Cherry Creek Learning Center provides an ideal learning environment for students. "First, each student has an Individual Learning Plan, which is developed by a highly qualified Hope Online teacher according to the academic needs of the student. Second, Learning Center mentors supervise and assist students as they work on their lessons. Third, students are allowed to work at their own pace; some of our students are advanced and therefore like to work ahead, while some of our students need additional time to comprehend a lesson before proceeding. Either way, the students benefit and are engaged in learning," asserts Ms. Griffith.

After a year at Hope Online, one fifth grader returned to his previous school; however, after only three weeks, he was failing his classes and fighting with other students. Now, he is back at Hope Online at Cherry Creek Learning Center, and he is excelling academically and socially. Ms. Griffith notes, "He, like many other students, needs our small, safe environment, and caring staff."

The Hope Online highly qualified teachers and Learning Center mentors care about the Hope Online students. One mentor spent time at the hospital with a student who was victimized by a gang-related crime. Ms. Griffith attests, "Knowing people care about them helps our students tremendously; they have higher self-esteem and are more confident. They are happier and less intimidated by school."

Ms. Griffith continues, "I have witnessed incredible academic progress in the students. I am committed to do my part to ensure Hope Online and Cherry Creek Learning Center attain our mutual goals of closing the achievement gap and reducing the dropout rate."
